

## **COVID-19 Guidelines:**

At this time **A Night of a Million Dreams – An Evening of Film, Food, Fireworks, and Wonder** will proceed as planned. As always, we are taking safety at our event seriously and we will continue to make any necessary updates and changes as needed per the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and NYS Health Guidelines.

**Are masks required?** Yes, masks are required at all times unless you're in your car. This is for the safety of everyone to include young children unable to be vaccinated, and immunocompromised individuals. Hand sanitizer will be made available as well.

**What about cleaning?** Staff and volunteers will deep clean and sanitize heavily used areas and surfaces throughout the evening.

**What about social distancing?** For the event, ticket sales will be limited so we can plan for more space for guests. Each group will get their own 9'x27' of space. Should you come with an oversized vehicle, this will reduce your groups space as the 9'x27' spaces are based on vehicles up to the size of a pickup truck. In any food line we ask that you stand 6 ft. apart.

**Can you walk around with your food?** We are kindly asking attendees to sit and eat in or around their car, instead of walking around.

**What if Covid-19 cases spike more during or before the event?** New Covid-19 cases and hospitalizations have been on the rise across New York for weeks now. Onondaga County is also seeing increases. Hospice of Central New York and the Finger Lakes will follow any new guidelines and policies required by the state at any time. If the state's policies on mass gatherings change, for example, we will adjust. Rules and plans could change at any point up until the day of the event.

**What if you have to cancel the event?** Should the event not be held on October 8, 2021 due to concerns of Covid-19 or due to local and state regulations, an alternate date for 2022 will be provided to all ticket holders. Should you choose not to attend the rescheduled event, or if you are unable to make it, Hospice of Central New York and Hospice of the Finger Lakes is happy to refund your ticket/donation upon request.
